Susanna Parker was a resident of Paterson New Jersey for a number of years, residing with her sister Harriett Luckey and Harriett's husband Dr. Luckey. Miss Parker remained in Paterson until her sister passed away in 1925, at which point she moved to Jenkintown PA to live in her niece's home. Once she had relocated to Pennsylvania, she made only a few trips back to Paterson. Miss Parker passed away between 1929 and 1930.

**Scope Note and Content:**

This collection consists of primarily archival material. The majority of records in the collection are financial papers, bank books, cancelled checks, account statements, and tax documents. The collection also includes some insurance and mortgage papers, as well as some court documents, personal letters and family photographs. The collection holds several photographs of The Great Falls in Paterson, New Jersey as well as a picture of The Guardian newspaper building. There are many letters to Susanna's nephew Dr. B.F. Luckey, he was a dentist in Paterson, New Jersey. Susanna Parker dealt with R.M. Eking's, which seems to be an insurance company. Miss Parker's financial holdings were held in First National Bank and The Paterson Saving Institution. The collection also housing Miss Parker's personal collection of obituaries.

**Series:**

The collection is organized into folders containing like items of the same subject matter. At the writing of this finding aid, the collection had already been divided into folders. No arrangement or organizational system created by Susanna Parker was evident.
