This collection primarily consists of programs and tickets related to music performances in Passaic County. A large component of this collection is a group of day calendars or booklets, related to the Musicians Mutual Protective and Benevolent Union. Within the collection there are also some sheets of music.

The two groups featured heavily within this collection are the Musicians Mutual Protective and Benevolent Union and the Paterson Philharmonic Society. Both of these groups were based in Paterson, N.J., making most of the material in this collection Paterson related. Material related to the Friday Afternoon Music Club and Iris Brussels are also included. Some programs refer to the Apollo Hall, Association Hall, Central High School and Eastside High School

Series:

Upon the creation of this finding aid, the documents within this collection were grouped together in a box. While these documents did not arrive at the Society at the same time, nor were they all given by the same donor, the common theme of music seems to be the common link. It was considered most useful to researchers that they remain together, however original accession numbers are noted on the box list, and photocopies of original accession records have been included in the relevant folders, to assist researchers.

This collection also contains duplicate copies of several of the items listed. Where relevant, the number of copies has also been noted on the box list.
