Scope and Content:

This collection mostly consists of Presidential Campaign pamphlets and fliers. There are some newspapers, magazines, and even a few buttons for presidential candidates. Famous politicians included are FDR, Eisenhower, Nixon (as VP) and even a few pieces on John F. Kennedy. Within a folder material on the 1936 Presidential Republican Campaign there is a flier on the New Deal. Folders 39 through 66 contain Gubernatorial and Senatorial campaign material. After that there are folders on: Race Track Gambling, College Bond Issue, State Voter Statutes, Socialist Labor Party, A & J Friedman Supply Co., Federal Housing Admin., Real Estate, Alloy Metalsmith Inc., Osmers Congressional Campaign, and State Civil Rights.
