This collection primarily consists of transportation timetables, flyers, and newspaper articles relating to the railroad. A large component of this collection contains Public Service Bus Schedules for various routes originating around Paterson, New Jersey. Another component of significant size is the material relating to the railroad. Also contained within this collection is information relating to ships and planes, but on a limited basis.

The Public Service Bus Company and the Erie Railroad are featured heavily within this collection. Other companies contained within are the Greyhound and Trailways Bus Company, as well as the Inter City Transportation Company. Mohawk Airlines is the only airline and information is limited. Railroads contained in the collection are the Erie RR, Lackawanna RR, New York Susquehanna & Western RR, Pennsylvania RR, and the Reading RR. The Cunard line is the main focus of the information relating to ships.

**Series:**

Upon the creation of the finding aid, the documents within this collection were grouped together in a box. These documents did not arrive at the Society at the same time, nor were they all given by the same donor. This collection was grouped together because the common theme of these documents is transportation and it was considered most to be most useful to researchers that they remain together.

This collection also contains duplicate copies of several of the items listed which are noted where relevant on the box list.
