Scope and Content:

This collection consists of five documents, all related to the transfer of a piece of property in the City of Passaic from a Mrs. Mary Frisbie of Passaic to Benjamin Harmon of New York. The deed is also included among the documents.

1. Letter to E. N. Frisbie from James A. Norton. Letter regarding Mrs. Frisbie and Mr. Berdan's account. Norton was an insurance agent at 9 Bloomfield Ave. (letter is on his letterhead) Written on Oct 23, 1891.
2. Letter to unknown from J...Perry Esq. of New York. Regarding a payment from Benjamin Harmon. ON Ashland House stationary. Written on July 6, 1892.
3. Letter to unknown from B. Harmon of New York regarding the transfer of the estate from E.N. Frisbie. On Harmon law office stationary. Written on Nov. 25 1891.
4. Letter, possibly from Mrs. Frisbie regarding a misunderstanding. Letter is difficult to read. Written on Delta Kappa Epsilon stationary, undated.
5. Deed transferring land from Mary Frisbie of Passaic to Benjamin Harmon of New York on Dec. 1 1892. The property in question was located near Lafayette Avenue in Passaic. One dollar was received in exchange.
