Biographical Information:

The Glen Rock Historical & Preservation Society, Inc. was incorporated in 1992 as a registered 501(C)3 non-profit organization. Their mission is to heighten the public's awareness of, and appreciation for, the history, growth and development of Glen Rock, New Jersey.

As part of the community outreach, they maintain and organize The Museum at the Station, located inside the Main Line Train Station. Here they showcase items from Glen Rock's past, with displays that change periodically as well as permanent exhibits featuring the Erie Railroad and artifacts from Glen Rock's farming history.

Scope and Content:

This collection consists of Kodachrome Stereo Transparency slides, photographs which were marked the Bennett Collection and a number of 8mm rolls of film. Most of the items seem to be unidentified but there are a few images from Paterson and Passaic County.
